## CONFERENCE PARKING

South Texas College of Law does not have a dedicated visitor parking lot. There are, however, many street-level parking lots within a few blocks of the law school.

A map identifying the locations of area parking lots is attached. Weekend parking rates typically range from \$2.00 to \$10.00 per day, depending on location.

We do not recommend parking in the high-rise garages around the law school as all of the ones we have visited are only open to the public for limited hours on Saturdays (and they are also much more expensive).

On the streets surrounding the law school, metered parking is also available. Please note that there should be a small decal posted on the front of each meter station to identify the maximum parking time allowed at that location.

Maximum parking times vary by street and are either 2, 4, 6 or 8 hours. You may park at any available metered street parking space – however you will only be able to pay for the posted maximum parking time. (This means that you will have to purchase additional time during the day if you park at a meter with a 2 to 6 hour limit).

The newer meter stations accept various forms of payment, including credit cards and cash. Older style meters only accept cash (quarters).

As with parking in any public place, we recommend that valuables not be left in view inside your vehicle.
