

Arrangement Schedule 2016

GENERAL RULES:

The Arrangement Division is governed by the rules of American Rose Society as stated in the current ARS *Guidelines for Judging Roses*. By entering this show given under ARS Rules, exhibitors agree to abide by those rules.

1. All roses must be outdoor grown and must be of high quality.
 2. A rose or roses must be the dominant flower in all arrangements.
 3. Names of all roses in each arrangement must be written on the ARS arrangement entry tag.
 4. "AG" should be written at the top of the entry tag if roses are arranger grown in order for the entry to be eligible for high ARS awards (medal certificates).
 5. One entry per exhibitor is allowed in each class, but an exhibitor may enter as many classes as desired.
 6. Accessories are allowed unless otherwise stated in this Schedule. Flowers other than roses and dried and/or treated dried plant materials are allowed unless prohibited by this Schedule.
 7. A card of intent may be included with the arrangement as an explanation of the arranger's interpretation of the theme or class title.
 8. All arrangements will be placed by the exhibitor in the space assigned to the Exhibitor. Exhibitors must remove the card and class number designating their space after placing the arrangement.
 9. All arrangements must be the work of the exhibitor.
 10. No one but the exhibitor may touch or move an arrangement.
 11. White foam core board niches 32" high and 24" wide will be provided for each standard arrangement **if requested**. Foam core board niches (10" x 10") will be provided for each miniature arrangement **if requested**. Backdrops may be furnished by the exhibitor.
 12. All entries must be PRE-REGISTERED by Thursday, October 20, 2016, with Susan Kelley, telephone 832-867-7013 or email suzzieq1971@gmail.com
 13. Entries will be accepted from 6:30 a.m. until 9:30 a.m. and must be removed at 4:00 p.m. on the day of the show.
 14. All possible care will be given to safeguarding arrangements, but neither the American Rose Society, the Houston Rose Society, the South Central District nor the Pasadena Convention Center assumes responsibility for loss or damage.
 15. Trophies and awards must be picked up at the close of the show on Saturday at 4:00 p.m.
 16. When a class states, "Exhibitor's choice of design," indicate design choice on the entry tag, or the arrangement will be judged as a traditional design.
- Infringement of the following rules will result in severe penalties.**
17. Painted or dyed fresh plant materials and live creatures are not allowed.
 18. The use of plant materials on State or local conservation lists is not permitted.
 19. The American flag or flag of any other country may not be used in an arrangement or as a decoration in any way.

There are only two causes for disqualification of an arrangement:

- Roses not outdoor grown;
- Use of artificial plant material.

"PRESIDENTIAL ROSES"

Class 1. **ARS Challenge – Ruth Tiedeman Trophy**

A standard size line-mass arrangement using two or more types of arranger grown roses, properly identified.

This class is **open only to ARS members**.

Keeper trophy sponsored by the Houston Rose Society.

South Central District Challenge Classes **Classes 2-5 Eligible to South Central Members Only**

Class 2. "Camelot"

A standard traditional arrangement using only fresh plant material. Roses must be arranger grown,

Keeper trophy sponsored by Raymond Hicks in memory of Frances Hicks.

Class 3. "War Between the States"

A standard modern arrangement. Roses must be arranger grown.

Keeper trophy sponsored by Don and Brenda Johnson in honor of Doug Helberg.

Class 4. "Gold Rush"

An arrangement using miniature and/or miniflora roses, exhibitor's choice of design (must be stated on tag), not to exceed 10 inches in height, width, or depth. Roses must be arranger grown.

Keeper trophy sponsored by Robin Hough in memory of Emily Zemp Hough.

Class 5. "Watergate"

An arrangement using miniflora roses, exhibitor's choice of design (must be stated on tag), not to exceed 12 inches in height, width, or depth.

Keeper trophy sponsored by Don and Brenda Johnson.

Standard Rose Arrangements

First place arrangements that are arranger grown and score at least 92 points are eligible for the ARS Gold, Silver and Bronze Arrangement Certificates.

Traditional

Eligible for ARS Royalty Award

Class 6. "Colonial Williamsburg"

A Mass design all fresh plant materials.

Class 7. "Seward's Folly"

Line design with other fresh or dried material

Oriental

Eligible for ARS Oriental Rosette

Class 8. "Boston Tea Party" – using a medium to tall container

Designers choice of traditional design (must state type)

Modern

Eligible for ARS Artist's Rosette

Class 9. "Golden Spike"

Modern design in Designer Choice (must state type)

Princess

Eligible for Princess of Arrangements Award

Class 10. "Monticello Gardens"

Fresh Roses and any other parts of the rose bush only. Including, but not limited to hips, canes (with or without foliage) and roots may be used. No other plant materials or accessories are permitted. Designers Choice (must state type)

Duchess

Eligible for Duchess of Arrangement Award

Class 11. "Trail of Tears"

Standard design with Fresh Roses with Dried and/or Treated plant material. No other fresh plant materials or accessories are permitted. Arrangers Choice of Design (must state type)

Duke

Eligible for Duke of Arrangement Award

Class 12. "Mount Rushmore"

Fresh Roses with or without fresh and/or dried plant material. Larger than 10 inches in height, with and depth but no greater than 20 inches in height, width or depth. No accessories are permitted. Designers Choice (must state type)

ARRANGEMENTS SCORE CARD

- **Conformance 15 Points**
 - Roses correctly named,
 - conformance to design type,
 - other specific requirements of schedule
- **Design (5 points per principle) 30 Points**
 - Balance, dominance, contrast,
 - rhythm, proportion and scale
- **Perfection of the rose(s) 30 Points**
 - and condition of other plant materials
- **Creativity and Expressiveness 15 Points**
- **Distinction 10 Points**
 - Unique, superior in every respect, including technical execution/construction

Eligible for Junior Arrangement Award

Class 13. "Honest Abe"

Junior Arrangement. Accessories are permitted. Designer Choice (must state type)

Standard Table Class

Eligible for Court Of Etiquette Award

Class 14. "White House Luncheon"

Functional Table Design

Miniature/Miniflora Designs

Only Roses so classified to be used

Not to exceed 10 inches in any direction

First place arrangements that are arranger grown and score at least 92 points are eligible for the ARS Miniature Gold, Silver and Bronze Arrangement Certificates.

Eligible for ARS Mini-Royalty Rosette

Class 15. "New Deal"

Mass Design with other flowers

Class 16. "Fireside Chat"

Line or line-mass

Oriental

Eligible for ARS Mini Oriental Rosette

Class 17. "Omaha Beach"

In a low container

Modern

Eligible for ARS Mini-Artists Rosette

Class 18. "Trickle Down"

Designers Choice (must state type)

Princess

Eligible for ARS Mini-Princess of Arrangement Rosette

Class 19. "Over There"

Fresh Miniature or miniflora roses and any other part of the rose bush only. Hips, canes (with or without foliage) and roots may be used. No other plant material or accessories are permitted. Designers Choice (must state type)

Duchess

Eligible for ARS Mini-Duchess Arrangement Rosette

Class 20. "Old Hickory"

Fresh miniature or miniflora roses with dried and/or treated plant material. No other fresh plant material or accessories permitted. Designers Choice (must state type)

Novice

Eligible for ARS Novice Certificate

Class 21. "Rough Rider"

Novice arranger, those who have not received any ARS Award before. Accessories permitted. Designers Choice (must state type)

Standard Keepsake

Eligible for Keepsake Award

Class 22. For Standard design with dried roses with or without dried and/or treated rose foliage or dried materials. All materials must be dried material.

Miniature Keepsake

Eligible for Miniature Keepsake Award

Class 23. For Miniature Design with dried Miniature/Miniflora Roses with or without and dried/or treated other plant materials.

Judges Class

Eligible for ARS Judges Certificate

For any Judge Judging this Show

Class 24. Choose from any class in show with design class listed. (See Rule 16)
